Recommended Reel & Tackle

Walleye: Light to medium 5' to 7' graphite rods with fast action tips, 6-10lb test line, ¼ to ½ oz jig heads (chartreuse, white, black, pumpkin and hot pink), Twister tails, 1 ½ to 2 ½" long and Lindy Rigs. We supply you with live bait daily.

Northern: Medium to medium heavy 6' to 7' graphite rods, 8-25lb test line, Red Eye Spoons, Dare Devil Spoons, Suicks, Bull Dawgs, Rapalas, Super Shad Rap, Mepps, Blue Foxes, Little Cleos, Large Bass Spinner Baits, Big Rat-L-Traps, Steel Leaders are recommended.

We are located on the shores of the English River, looking south to where the English River meets the Winnipeg River at Tetu Lake. Our destination is an idyllic location. 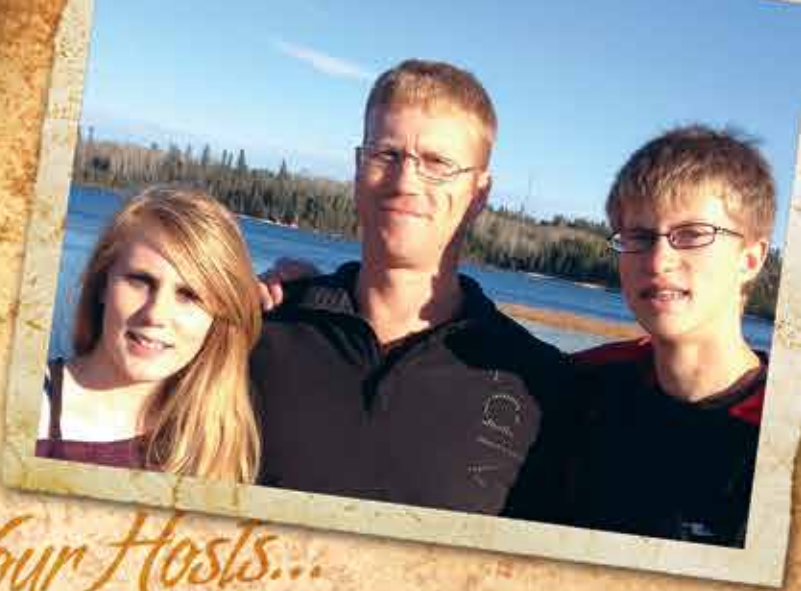

Driving Directions

If you are coming through International Falls, take Hwy 11 west to Hwy 71. Then take Hwy 71 north to Hwy 17, and turn left towards Kenora. You will come to the Kenora bypass 17A: take it to Hwy 596 and turn right. It will be 25 miles to the Minaki junction where you will turn left on to Hwy 525. After you have driven 17 miles you will come to the Whitedog Dam. Cross it. Continue until you reach a fork in the road. There is a 'CARIBOU FALLS LODGE' sign. Take the RIGHT side and continue for approximately 6 miles. You will see two of our signs on the right hand side but the driveway is on the left at the second sign. Turn left and follow the LONG driveway to your destination!

If you are coming from Winnipeg, take Hwy 1 - it becomes Hwy 17 when you cross the Ontario border. Take Hwy 17 to Kenora bypass 17A on the left. Turn left at Hwy 596, then proceed as above.
